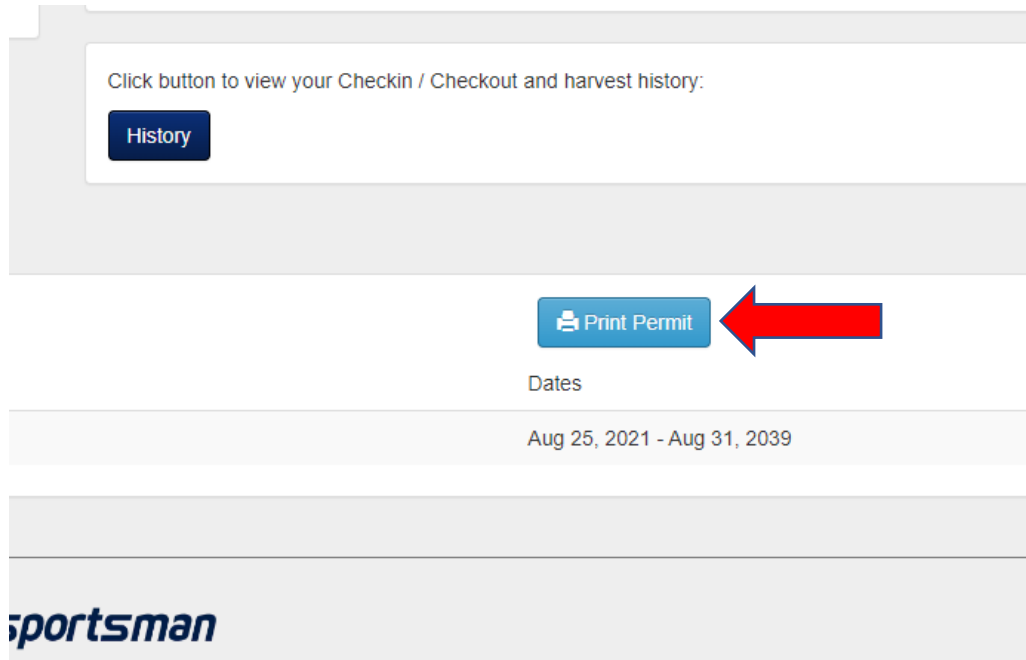
Step 4

- Display vehicle pass on driver's side dashboard whenever recreating down range

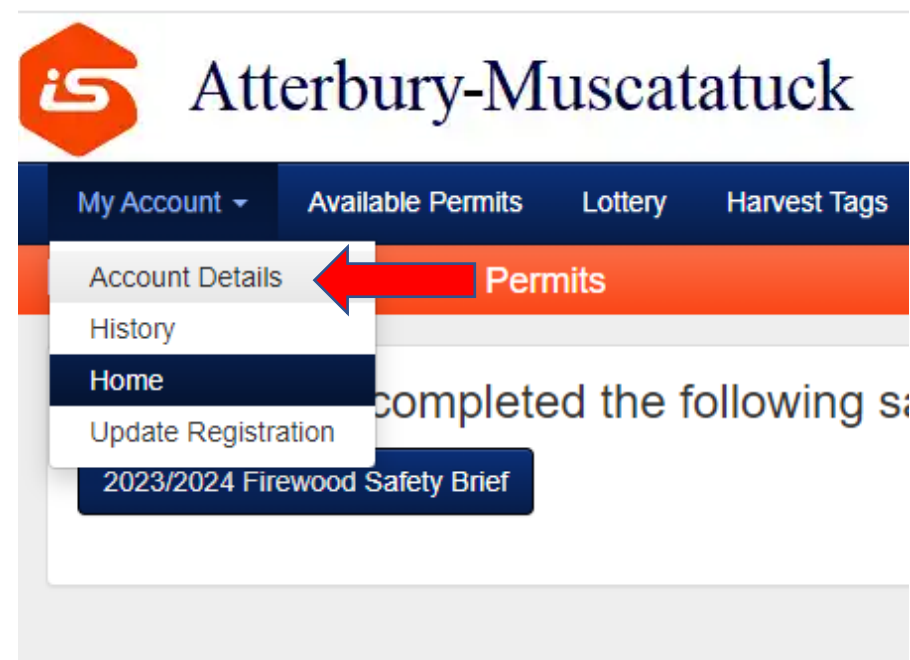


If you have multiple vehicles that you will bring on post, do the following:

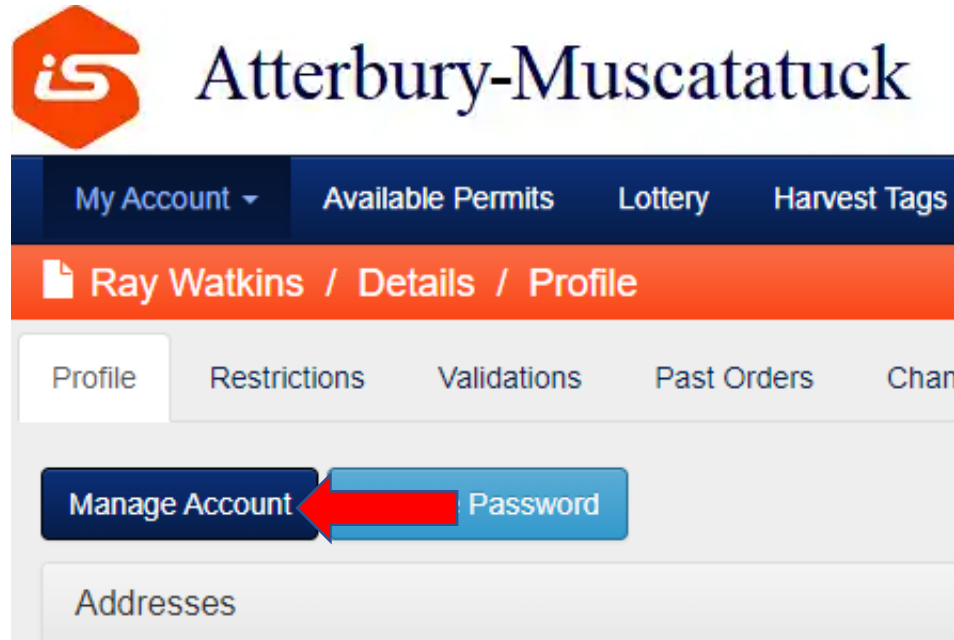
- Print permit for your primary vehicle.
